### **1. AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS**

- The ASEBP Trustees approved the audited financial statements for the year ended August 31, 2022. The external auditors gave an unqualified opinion.
- Over the year, ASEBP continued to focus on solid financials and fiscal management to help deliver high-value health and income replacement benefits at a reasonable cost to covered members and their dependants.
- Trust assets are prudently invested and, as a result, reserves remain fully funded and current premium rates have been moderated.
